HSSTF follow-up: Right to Health campaign

Subsequent to the meeting, decisions reached at the plenary sessions and the incisive inputs from the working groups have been integrated into the final plan of action.

- The SUBRACs/RECs will deliberate on the specific modes of implementing the PSI Action Plan of the Right to Health campaign in each region for 2017, during their meetings in February/March;
- The SUBRAC/RECs meetings will also resolve on the three persons from each region who would comprise the HSSTF coordination, as discussed.
