Sir,

We take opportunity to inform that 130,000 members of our organization employed in the largest National Public Utility namely WAPDA/Elecy. having almost 180 Millions Industrial and Commercial and Rural and Domestic Consumers have been facing threat of Privatization on the behest of I.M.F including:-

- i) Handing over the management of Nine Thermal Power Stations to the Private Management.
- ii) Privatization o the most profitable Distribution Companies namely Islamabad and Faisalabad.
- iii) Out sourcing Billing of Elecy. Consumers.

The Copy of the Press Cuttings are enclosed containing Press Conference of the Finance & Water & Power Federal Minister.

2. That, the union held mass Protest on 1st November, 2011 all over the country. As a result of that, the President of Pakistan decided to with-held the said decision and assured that the decision would not be made without consulting the Stake Holders.

3. Despite this, the Government has been persuing the Policy of Privatization of Elecy. and has disbanded Pakistan Electric Power Company and has been outsourcing the management of nine National Thermal Power Station

That, the union has again held a mass demonstration in all the major cities on 8th December, 2011 successfully and decided to continue till a positive decision was not taken through a bilateral meeting with the representatives of the union as promised Worthy President of Pakistan on 1st November, 2011. The copies of the Press Cuttings are enclosed.

5. That, the union has filed a Writ Petition in Sind High Court under Article 199 of the Constitution of Pakistan of the Constitution to challenge the disbanding of unified Elec. System under Pakistan Electric Power Company which has been admitted for hearing.

In such circumstances, we request your goodself that you may kindly use your office to write to Managing Director, IMF and the President World Bank that they may incorporate the policy of Consultation with the Stake Holder namely our representatives National Industry-wise this Trade Union pressing the Government not to pursue de-Regulation of the National Elec. Public Utility. Since it will not only create Inter Provincial Dispute on differential Power Tariff alike existing dispute on Water Distribution, but also it will create chaos alike the bitter experience of Privatization of Karachi Electric Supply Company. It will be also against the public interest. We will appreciate the some technical assistance is extended for providing "CAPACITY BUILDING" of the workers organization in the form some expert on the subject for assisting the union by provision with comparative experience to defend and promote the fundamental Rights of workers against threat of Privatization and oblige.
