## Practical Information

### 3. Airport and Transport arrangement

Ngurah Rai International Airport is the main airport in Bali, with two terminals that is for domestic and international.

PSI has coordinated with the Patra Bali Resort and Spa to arrange your transport from the airport to the hotel based with your itinerary (**arrival date, time and flight number**) that you has given to regional office. If not, please send to us immediately. **For the sponsored participants, we will not reimburse your taxi claim as we are arranging the transport.**

If you miss this service, just go to Taxi Counter in the Airport and cost you IDR 50,000 to IDR 70,000 (can be less) to The Patra Bali resort & Villas. It will take you around 5 (five) minutes.

### 4. Visas Requirement

This is important note for you that you do and do not require a Visa to enter Bali. Starting 28th May 2007, the government through Ministerial Decree by the Minister of Law and Human Rights, has extended Visa on Arrival (VoA) facilities to another 11 countries, bringing to a total of 63 countries, whose nationals may enter Indonesia by taking Visa on Arrival.

VOA arrival costs US\$25 for 30 days. Processing is relatively fast in Bali and those who cannot pay in US\$ can change money on the spot at a moneychanger. VOA is non-extendible, so you'll have to leave Indonesia and return if you want to stay longer. The official entry requirements for the issuance of a 30 or 7 days day visa-on arrival.

Countries which are not listed for visa on arrival must apply for Indonesia visa at Indonesia Embassy/Consulate in respective country, such as **Tonga and Sri Lanka**. Please contact us and we will provide you letter to apply the visa.

Bali's is tropical climate. Every year round temperature averaging 31 degrees Celsius. High humidity can be expected during the Wet Season between the months of October - April. The Dry Season between the months of May - September has also the lowest humidity. Meeting hall always with air-conditioned, so you might need to plan for a few sweaters or jacket to keep comfort.

### 6. Indonesian Currency

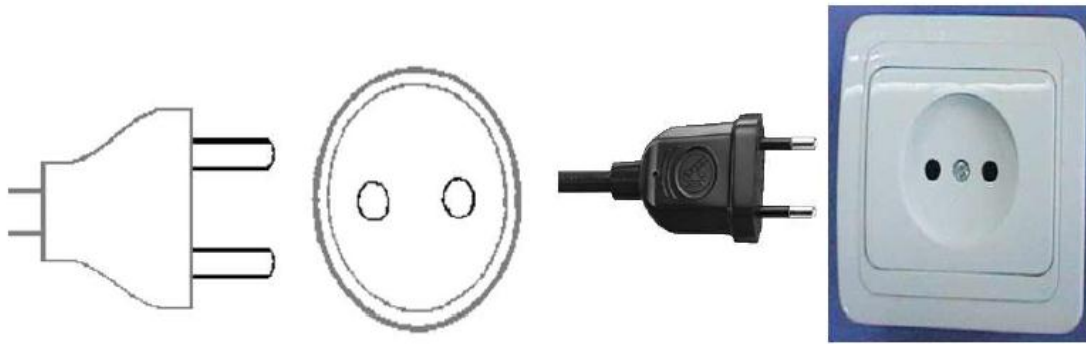
